Pascal: Difference between REPEAT..UNTIL and WHILE..DO

Pascal supports two forms of conditional loop: REPEAT..UNTIL and WHILE..DO.

A loop of the form

REPEAT

UNTIL <condition>

will be executed at least once, even if the condition is satisfied before the first execution.

The loop consisting of

WHILE <condition> DO

will be executed ONLY if the condition is satisfied when the loop is entered. For further information, see pages 22 and 23 of the Pascal User Manual and Report.
