

## **Instant Pascal: RGB Color**

Instant Pascal: RGB Color

-----

For the current release of Instant Pascal, the Extended 80 Column Color card is not activated at boot time. This was a deliberate design decision. Double highers text, even with the 40 column option selected, does not look satisfactory on a Color 100 monitor (or other RGB monitors).

However, for customers who already have RGB monitors and who wish to use Instant Pascal in color, there is a pre-boot workaround to turn on the card. From ProDOS Basic, type and save the following program:

- 10 D\$ = CHR\$(4)
- 20 PRINT D\$;"PR#3": PRINT
- 30 POKE 49246,0
- 40 POKE 49247,0
- 50 POKE 49246,0
- 60 POKE 49247,0
- 70 POKE 49246,0
- 80 CALL 50688

LOAD the program into your IIe and place the Instant Pascal STARTUP disk in the drive configured to Slot 6, Drive 1 and RUN the program. Instant Pascal will function as usual with the addition. Text will be difficult to read.
