LaserWriter: Driver errors

An "Error in PostScript" message means that there is an error in the code generated in the driver that Apple has written. The error messages, generated by the application, would vary with the application.

Here is a list of the Printer Manager errors:

| Error Value | Description                       |
|-------------|-----------------------------------|
| 0           | No error                          |
| 128         | Abort the printing process        |
| -1          | Problem saving print file         |
| -17         | Unimplemented control instruction |
| -27         | Trouble with I/O                  |
| -108        | Not enough heap space             |

The following errors are relevant to the LaserWriter ONLY.

|       |  |
|-------|--|
| -4101 | Printer closed or not found              |
| -4100 | Connection just closed                   |
| -4099 | Write request too big                    |
| -4098 | Request already active                   |
| -4097 | Bad connection refNum                    |
| -4096 | Ne free Connect COntrol Blocks available |
