If you need to upload and download files between a Macintosh and an Unisys A4FX mainframe, consider Avenue Software's Contact product. If the connection is asynchronous, you only need the software. If not, you will need their TDI/RS-232 converter, too. Multiple station connectors are available at a lower cost per workstation price. (Avenue Software specializes in terminal emulator and data transfer software for transferring files to/from Unisys mainframes.)
