TOPIC -----

I want to use my Macintosh as a front end for Mathematica running on my NeXT computer. Is this possible?

DISCUSSION -----

According to Wolfram Research Technical Support, the Macintosh CAN be used as a front end for Mathematica running on the NeXT computer.

To do this, you need Mathematica for the Macintosh and the NeXT. Wolfram has a document called "Macintosh TCP/IP Installation Guide" -- free to registered owners of Mathematica -- that describes how to use MacTCP and Mathematica to connect to the NeXT computer and how to use the Mathematica kernel on the NeXT computer.
