DISCUSSION -----Both are based on the same design, but there are four major differences: - The IIg has 5MB of RAM, which is the minimum required for PhotoGrade printing. The IIf can support PhotoGrade with the addition of a 4MB RAM Upgrade kit. - Ethernet is built into the IIg. It is not available on the IIf. - The processor on the IIg runs at 25Mhz compared to 20Mhz for the IIf.

- The IIf is less expensive.
