DISCUSSION -----

The backup batteries used in Apple products contain less than 0.5G of lithium. Therefore, they meet CFR 173.206 (Code of Federal Regulations) requirements and are considered nonrestricted articles in transportation and should not need Materials Safety Data Sheets.
