TOPIC -----

I'm using ClarisWorks 1.0v2 on a Macintosh SE/30 running system software version 6.0.7. When I print to my StyleWriter, the first line of each paragraph (beginning with the second paragraph) is slightly indented. These indents vary from paragraph to paragraph.

When I print the same documents to a LaserWriter printer, the printouts are aligned properly.

DISCUSSION -----

This is a known problem with ClarisWorks versions 1.0 and 1.0v2 when printing to a StyleWriter. Claris recently released version 1.0v3, which corrects the problem.
