TOPIC -----

Using Digital PATHWORKS and a LaserWriter Plus, the Palatino font option characters don't come out right. For example, a "bullet" comes out as a "%" sign.

DISCUSSION -----

Digital told us that this is a known problem, and you need to set the printer to 8-bit mode. Here are two PostScript files to do this. Print the following two files in the PATHWORKS directory:

msa\$root:[msa.msap\$utility] to your printer to set the printer to 8-bit
mode:

msap\$set_params.ps
msap\$show_params.ps

The second file prints a confirmation sheet on the printer.
