What's the difference between the SNA•ps Gateway versions: SNA•ps Gateway/8, SNA•ps Gateway/32, and SNA•ps Gateway/64?

DISCUSSION -----

The three products are functionally identical except for the number of LUs (Logical Units) they support: 8, 32, or 64. Logical Units are defined in IBM's Systems Network Architecture (SNA), and equate roughly to the number of sessions that can be concurrently running between Macintosh clients and IBM mainframes.
