The Macintosh PowerBook 145 ships with system software version 7.0.1. Because version 7.0.1 was released before the PowerBook 145 was introduced, the system software doesn't contain information with which to report this computer as a PowerBook 145.

This article addresses some peculiarities you may notice.

About This Macintosh ...

When you check the "About This Macintosh ..." item in the Apple menu, it shows PowerBook 140. However, both the product label on the bottom case and the silkscreen on the display bezel correctly show the model as a Macintosh PowerBook 145.

Installing System Software

If you select "Custom Install", there is no Installer script labeled PowerBook 145. Choose the script labeled PowerBook 140 to install the proper software.

If you select "Easy Install", the correct software will be installed.

These items have been fixed in system software version 7.1.
