TOPIC -----

Can I put the Macintosh PowerBook 145, which runs at 25 MHz, into power-saver mode (16 MHz) via the Battery desk accessory, like the PowerBook 170?

DISCUSSION -----

No, with system software version 7.0.1, you cannot slow the Macintosh PowerBook 145 processor down to 16 MHz.

This feature is available with System 7.1. It's been moved from the Battery DA to an option in the new PowerBook control panel.

Note

If the PowerBook 145 had its expansion board replaced with the PowerBook 170 board, you can put it into power-saver mode via the Battery DA with version 7.0.1.
