The original LaserWriter IIf and LaserWriter IIg print two blank pages after a	
paper jam is cl	leared. This serves two purposes:
• To clean exce	ess toner from the paper path

Unlike the earlier LaserWriter printers, the LaserWriter IIf and IIg re-print the page that was printing when the jam occurred.

• To verify that a jam condition does not still exist before trying to image

another page.
