TOPIC -----

Can I use AppleTalk Remote Access (ARA) to connect to an ARA system via Tymnet? I can dial up a Tymnet modem, input a terminal type (a character "A" or "O"), input my network username and password, and then Tymnet connects me (via hard-wired connection) to a Macintosh running ARA. Is this possible with ARA?

DISCUSSION -----

You can use the Apple Remote Access Multiport Server X.25 Extension to use ARA over an X.25 network such as Tymnet or Sprint.
