TOPIC -----

I tried to save a received file to the Desktop after receiving a file in MacTerminal 3.0 with Straight Xmodem, Standard.

It didn't put the files there, instead the files are located in MacTerminal folder as:

File being received... 1
File being received... 2

DISCUSSION -----

This is how MacTerminal 3.0 was designed. When you select the Folder For Received Files, if you want to direct incoming files to the folder whose contents is currently displayed, click the Select Current folder button; otherwise, click the folder where you want to direct incoming files and then click the Select button.

You got the results you did because the MacTerminal folder was selected and then you clicked Select; had you clicked on Desktop then on Select Current folder, the files would have been saved to the desktop.
