Can I take my U.S./Japan version StyleWriter overseas?

DISCUSSION -----

The StyleWriter II power supply is built in to the printer, unlike the original StyleWriter which had an external power transformer.

### Two Versions

-----  
The StyleWriter II is manufactured in two versions:

- The U.S./Japan version uses 100 to 120 volt power at 48 to 62 Hertz.
- The European version uses 220 to 240 volt power at 48 to 62 Hertz.

### Using In Another Country

- 
- To use a U.S./Japan model StyleWriter II in Europe, you must use an isolation step-down transformer to reduce the electrical voltage.
  - To use a European model in the U.S. or Japan, you must use a isolation step-up transformer.
