Marking Engine

- Thermal ink jet

Memory

- 128K (62K used for buffer)

Speed

- Best mode: up to one page per minute
- Normal and draft: up to two pages per minute (actual speed varies depending on images printed and computer used)

Print Quality

- 360 dpi in best and normal modes
- 180 dpi in draft mode
- Grayscale printing with GrayShare software

Fonts

- 39 TrueType fonts from the following font families: ITC Avant Garde Gothic, ITC Bookman, Chicago, Courier, Geneva, Helvetica, Helvetica Narrow, Monaco, New Century Schoolbook, New York, Palatino, Symbol, Times, ITC Zapf Chancery, ITC Zapf Dingbats

Interface

- High-speed serial (RS-422)

Ink Cartridge

- User-replaceable
- Up to 500 pages at 5% page coverage

Paper Feed

- Automatic up to 100 sheets (fewer sheets if heavier paper is used) or 15 envelopes

Print materials

- Apple recommends 20-lb. (75 g/m²) cotton bond; also accepts 16-lb. (60 g/m²) to 24-lb (90 g/m²) paper
- Paper sizes: U.S. letter, U.S. legal, A4
- Most letterhead and colored stock, labels, envelopes, and transparencies
- Envelopes: #10 business, monarch, and other sizes
- Apple recommends 3M brand CG3480 transparency film

Paper capacity

- Multipurpose tray: up to 100 sheets of 20 lb. paper (fewer sheets if heavier paper is used) or 15 envelopes

Printable surface

- Maximum printable line: 8.0 in. (203.2 mm)
- Minimum margins: 0.25 in. (6.35 mm)

Size and weight

- Height: 7 in. (18 cm)
- Width: 13.6 in. (34.5 cm)
- Depth with output tray closed: 7.9 in. (20 cm)
- Weight: 6.6 lb. (3 kg.)

Power requirements

- Europe and Australia: 220 to 240 VAC, 48 to 62 Hz

Power consumption

- 19.5 W maximum at 120 V
- 18 W maximum at 220 V

- Any Apple Macintosh personal computer with at least 1MB of RAM and a hard

disk drive

- System software version 6.0.7 or later
- Recommended: 2MB or more RAM with System 6.0.7 or 6.0.8
4MB or more RAM with System 7 or later
