TOPIC -----

- 1) Is the Color Classic compatible with software and hardware designed for the Macintosh LC?
- 2) Can my Macintosh Color Classic run Apple IIe software?
- 3) Can I add Ethernet networking to my Color Classic?

DISCUSSION -----

- 1) Yes, the Macintosh Color Classic is fully compatible with the Macintosh LC line.
- 2) Yes, if Apple's Apple IIe Card is installed in the expansion slot inside the Color Classic, you can run Apple IIe software. The Apple IIe Card for Macintosh LC (v2.2) is order number M0444LL/C; it works in the Color Classic as well as in the Macintosh LC.
- 3) Yes, you can install Apple's Ethernet card in the expansion slot. The Apple Ethernet LC Card is order number M0443LL/B. You need a transceiver in addition to the Ethernet card itself.
