Claris sent this list of fonts that can cause problems with MacWrite II 1.1v4 and earlier versions.

DISCUSSION -----

Apple Font Pack Problems - "Font not Installed" Message

We have confirmed a problem with MacWrite II 1.1v4 and earlier, combined with System 7.0.1 or 7.1 and the Apple TrueType Font Pack:

If you use System 6 (with TrueType installed), 7.0.1 or 7.1, and have any of the following fonts installed, you may receive the "this document uses a font that is not installed, possibly XXX" message. The fonts that we have identified are as follows:

- Garamond Narrow
- Helvetica Black
- Helvetica Compressed
- Lubalin Graph
- Nadianne
- Swing

After the message appears, the document will open in the Chicago font.

Correcting the Problem

You have a variety of options:

- Remove the fonts from the Font Folder.
- Use Find/Change on Attributes to change the font from Chicago to the

desired font.

You will continue to get this message until you remove the fonts.

NOTE: MacWrite II 1.1v4 was an in-line revision only. MacWrite Pro doesn't have this problem .
