TOPIC -----

This technical note describes user disk space considerations for DAL VAX/VMS Servers.

DISCUSSION -----

DAL client users must have some disk space on the host server machine to run the DAL Server. When the user's host account has zero available blocks on the account's default physical disk, a DAL error message is generated during any data exchange request. The error message reads: "Error Creating Object."

If DAL user accounts are set up without default disk space, the system administrator can specify an alternative location for the DAL server to find (and use) free disk by defining the VMS logical CL1TEMPDIR.

This variable should be defined to the name of a directory, such as USER:[TEMP].

The DAL user must have read/write and delete permission for the directory.
