This article de	escribes a workaround for Oracle 6.0 with DAL.
DISCUSSION	
Oracle database	olem in Oracle 6.0 which will not allow you to re-open an e in one DAL session. In other words, you cannot open, n open the database again.
For example, the following sequence leads to an error from Oracle 6.0:	
more> close o	
Execution beg Execution Cor	gins mpleted Successfully
more> go Execution beg Error -10207	database 'daldemo' user 'scott' password 'tiger'; gins (-6203) daldemo () network", line 1: Error during Connect - 6203
The problem will also occur after an unsuccessful attempt to open a database. For example, if you try to open a database with an invalid userid or password, subsequent attempts to open the database will fail.	

The work-around to this problem is to end the current DAL session and begin a new one. The bug only occurs in Oracle 6.0 prior to release 6.0.34, not

in version 5.1.
