TOPIC -----

I was trying to open a file that was compressed with DiskDoubler as a self-extracting archive. I got error -39. Why?

DISCUSSION -----

The problem is not necessarily associated with DiskDoubler. When extracting compressed archives, make sure you have enough room on your hard disk. Unfortunately, applications do not always display an error message when needed because of an application problem or extension conflict.

If you have enough space on the hard disk, try downloading the file again. The archive may have been damaged during transfer. It is also possible that the file was defective when compressed. You may want to contact the individual or group that originally compressed the file.
