TOPIC -----

This article addresses questions on paper handling options with the LaserWriter Pro printer.

DISCUSSION -----

Question: If a 500 sheet tray is added, can it be chosen as a separate paper source if a customer wants to have three different types of paper?

Answer: Yes, the user will have three paper sources to choose from. The 500 sheet feeder does act as a completely separate paper source.

Question: Can a 500 sheet tray be chosen as the next source if the 100 or 250 sheet trays are empty?

Answer: Yes. The user must set this up via the LaserWriter Utility 7.4.

Question: Can more than one 500 sheet feeder/tray be added to the printer?

Answer: The printer can only one 500 sheet feeder mechanism attached at any one time.

Question: If customers add an envelope feeder, will they have three different paper sources to choose from?

Answer: Yes. Once the envelope tray is attached, it will appear as an additional paper input source to choose from.

Question: If customers add an envelope feeder and a 500 sheet tray, will they have four sources to choose from?

Answer: Yes, this is the maximum at the current time. The user will have four input sources to choose from.

Question: If customers adds an envelope feeder, will they be able to use the manual feed option?

Answer: Yes, adding a envelope feeder does NOT disable the multipurpose tray.

NOTE: Remember that once a paper input source has been added, the User Test Print will indicate that the additional input paper sources are attached. However the printer driver will not show these paper input sources as additional selections until the printer driver is configured.

Steps to configure the driver:

Step 1

Choose Chooser from the Apple menu.

Step 2

Select the LaserWriter icon.

Step 3

Select a LaserWriter Pro printer for printing.

Step 4

Click Setup. This will prepare the LaserWriter driver for all input sources installed.

NOTE: The Setup button in the Chooser is located next to the background printing radio button. The button will either read Setup (if you are setting up the printer for the first time) or Review.

Step 5

The printer driver will now have these additional paper input sources as selections.
