Open the Map Control Panel located within the Control Panel folder inside your System Folder. If the map is black-and-white, open up the Scrapbook under the Apple Menu. Locate and copy the color map. Then go back to the Map Control Panel and Paste.

- Scroll around the map by clicking in the map and then dragging outside its boundaries.
- To find a city, type the name of the city and click on the Find button.
- To add a city, type in its name, click on its location, and click on the Add City button.
- The mileage display normally shows the distance between the last location you clicked and the present one. If you always want the distance displayed to be the distance between your home town and the current location, click on your town, then click the Set button.
- The Time Zone shows the difference between your current location and Greenwich mean time. If you wish to know the time difference between your previous and current location, click on the words Time Zone and it will switch to Time Differ.
- To see a more magnified version of the Map, hold the Option key down as you double click to open the Map control panel.
