TOPIC -----

I Have a Performa 405. Can I restore part of the data, or even just one file, from my backup disks created using Apple Backup, or do I have to restore the entire hard drive?

DISCUSSION -----

Apple Restore only allows you to restore the entire disk, not just individual parts. As a general rule, Preference files, like a Help file, can usually be thrown away. If you've lost a Preference file, don't restore to retrieve it. The application that created them will recreate them the next time launch the application.
