Are there any parts or modules that should be replaced at regular intervals to maintain optimal print quality on the LaserWriter Pro 600 and 630?

DISCUSSION -----

There is no refurbishment kit currently available for the LaserWriter Pro 600 and 630, however, several parts should be replaced at regular intervals if a deterioration in print quality or paper handling is noticed. Use the table below as a guide for determining when the consumable parts should be replaced.
