TOPIC -----

How can I conserve power and extend battery life on my Newton?

DISCUSSION -----

Your Newton automatically conserves power by turning off various circuits when they're not in use. To extend battery life, follow these steps:

- 1) Use the AC power adapter whenever you can.
- 2) Turn your Newton off when you're not using it.
- 3) Set a shorter period of time before your Newton goes to sleep.
- 4) Avoid beaming items and using the communications port when Newton is not plugged into the AC adapter.
- 5) Avoid setting your Newton to receive beams automatically.
- 6) Avoid switching on both text recognizers at the same time.
