This article describes your Newton's preferences.

DISCUSSION -----

You can select a number of your Newton's preferences to tailor your Newton to the way you work.

To open your Newton's Preferences window, tap the Extras button, then tap Prefs. You can select any preference by tapping it in the Preferences window.

The Newton's user-selectable preferences are:

- Personal
This option allows you to enter your personal information, such as name, company, address, country, fax and home phone.
- Date and Time
This option allows you to set the current date and time.
- Locate
This option allows you to choose what country's standards to use, such as country, keyboard and paper size. Do not change the country setting while filling out a form. Be sure to close the form first.
- Sound
This option allows you to control the types and volume of sound the Newton plays.
- Sleep
This option allows you to set how long you want your Newton to wait for activity before turning itself off.

- Memory
This option allows you to control where new items are stored, to see how much memory is available, and to remove software.
- Pen Alignment
This option allows you to realign Newton's pen.
- Recognizers
This option allows you to remove word from your vocabulary list and control how the text and shape interpreters work.
- Handwriting Style
This option allows you to tell Newton about your writing style to improve handwriting recognition.
- Letter Styles
This option allows you to tell Newton about the way you write specific characters to improve handwriting recognition.
- Handwriting Practice
This option allows you to see how well Newton can interpret your handwriting.
- Beam
This option allows you to specify how your Newton receives information by infrared beam.
- Modem
This option allows you to set options for your modem.
- Mail
This option allows you to set options for electronic mail.
