TOPIC -----

This article discusses how to put your Newton into sleep mode.

DISCUSSION -----

To conserve power, you can set your Newton to turn itself off after a specified period of time. This state is called "sleep mode", in which your Newton shuts itself off and preserves your data.

To set the amount of time before your Newton goes to sleep, follow these steps:

- 1) Tap the Extras button, then tap Prefs.
- 2) Tap Sleep. When the dialog box opens, tap the diamond to the left of Sleep. You will see a list of choices for the amount of time delay before Newton goes to sleep. Tap your choice.
- 3) Tap X to close Prefs, the tap X again to close Extras.
