TOPIC-----

I keep trying to scrub out a single character in a word, but Newton always thinks I'm adding a new letter. Do I scrub out the whole word and start over, or can I scrub out one character at a time?

DISCUSSION-----

Yes, you can scrub out a single letter within a word or even a single blank space. Simply draw at least four lines vertically through the character without lifting the stylus. For best results, use short, precise strokes.
