Newton: Can I Modify Graphics Without Redrawing? (7/93)

TOPIC-----

Can I modify or move graphics without redrawing them?

DISCUSSION-----

To change the shape of a graphic you have already drawn, put a selection box around it. Now you have several options for changing the appearace of the drawing:

- To move or change a line, drag it with the stylus.
- To move the entire drawing, place the stylus in the middle and drag it to a new location.
- To shrink, enlarge, or distort a drawing, drag the corners of the selection box.
- To change the thickness of the lines of the whole graphic, you may either box select the whole drawing, or just the lines you want to change. Then tap the Styles icon in the Extras drawer and choose the line thickness from the four examples on the right side of the Styles window.
