Duo and PowerBook: Batteries Not Interchangeable (8/93)

TOPIC -----

Can I use the batteries from my Duo in my PowerBook? They seem to last longer than the ones in my PowerBook.

DISCUSSION -----

No. Members of the PowerBook line all have different batteries, and they are not meant to work across models.

Battery types for the PowerBook line:

- PowerBook 100 lead-acid
- other non-Duo PowerBooks Nickel-Cadmium (NiCad)
- PowerBook Duo Nickel-Hydrate (NiHy)

The Duo's batteries may last longer than batteries used in other PowerBooks if you properly maintain and recharge them. However, the two battery types are not interchangeable. In fact, the batteries for one model will not fit in the battery slots for another.
