How can I switch quickly between the Finder and At Ease?

DISCUSSION -----

To easily switch between At Ease and the Finder, you can use the Go To commands under the File menu, or create a Finder button in At Ease.

To create a Finder button:

- 1) Open the System folder.
- 2) Click once on the Finder Icon.
- 3) Select Make Alias from the File menu.
- 4) Drag the Finder alias into the At Ease Items folder.

This creates a Finder button on the At Ease desktop to switch you instantly to the Finder. However, when you switch to the Finder, aliases continue to be made for your documents in At Ease.
