TOPIC -----

I am trying to run Apple Backup on my Performa, but I keep a message that my disk cannot be used. This occurs no matter what type of disk I insert.

DISCUSSION -----

If you have Stuffit 3.0.6 installed, and have the SpaceSaver option enabled, Apple Backup cannot use any of your disks.

To get around this, you must disable Stuffit when you are backing up. To do this, start up your Performa with extensions turned off: hold down the Shift key as you turn on the computer. Stuffit is not loaded, and Apple Backup should function properly.
