### TOPIC -----

This article discusses upgrades options for Macintosh PowerBook Duo 250 and 270c computers.

### DISCUSSION -----

The PowerBook Duo 250 can be upgraded to the Duo 280 and the PowerBook Duo 270c can be upgraded to the Duo 280c through a logic board upgrade. The Duo 280 upgrade replaces the Duo 250's logic board with Duo 280 logic board. Upgrade from a black and white display to an active-matrix color display is not available.

The Duo 280 logic board upgrade does not include a replacement display bezel and as a result, the unit will show the older model name after the upgrade. It is possible to identify an upgraded system by a newer FCC identification label affixed to the bottom of the unit.

To upgrade your PowerBook Duo in the United States, contact the Apple Assistance Center at 1-800-SOS-APPL, service providers cannot perform either upgrade. In other countries, contact your local Apple authorized service provider.
