TOPIC -----

The following anomalous result occurs with the use of specific strings in the answer command:

answer "4^2 =" && 4^2

results in 4 = 16

DISCUSSION -----

It turns out that the answer command ignores the substrings $^{\circ}0", ^{\circ}1", ^{\circ}2", ^{\circ}3"$, whenever any of these appear in the text prompt of the answer command (probably for all variations and probably also in the "ask" command.)

This is a feature of the Dialog Manager, which treats these strings as placeholders.

For more technical detail, see the ParamText procedure in Inside Mac Volume I.
