TOPIC -----

I'm using the Apple Phone 1.0 application with my Quadra 840AV and GeoPort Telecom Adapter in hands free mode. I'm getting feedback from the speakers in the AudioVision 14-inch Display. How can I eliminate the feedback?

DISCUSSION -----

The feedback is a result of a design deficiency in the Apple Phone application. Apple Phone does not have Echo Cancellation Code to prevent feedback. There are several workarounds you can use to eliminate the feedback:

- 1) If you are using the AudioVision 14-inch Display, set the volume controls to their midpoints. This will eliminate much of the feedback.
- 2) Connect the PlainTalk microphone to the microphone jack on the Macintosh or to the Monitor, if applicable. Position the microphone away from and behind the speakers to reduce the feedback.
- 3) Connect a pair of headphones to the sound out jack. This will eliminate all feedback.
