TOPIC -----

I'm trying to use Apple Remote Access with GeoPort Adpater on my Macintosh AV computer. According to page 118 in the Express Fax Modem User's Guide, I need a CCL description file apparently other than the file used to connect to AppleLink. Where can I find this file?

DISCUSSION -----

The manual refers to the name of the file which is used by the PowerBook Express modem. With a GeoPort Adapter, you need the file called "Geoport™ Telecom" installed in the Extensions folder inside the System Folder. The Express Modem for GeoPort software Installer properly install this file.

All the other files required for Apple Remote Access should be installed by the Apple Remote Access Installer. However, you need to remove the file called "Serial Port Arbitrator" from the Extensions folder inside the System Folder. The Serial Port Arbitrator file is not required in this instance. Failure to remove the Serial Port Arbitrator file may result an Error -23.
