Newton Messaging Card: In Box Limitation (1/94)

TOPIC -----

When a Newton Messaging Card that has received more than ten pages (or messages) is inserted into a Newton MessagePad, only the last 10 pages are shown in the MessagePad's In Box.

Why aren't the remaining pages displayed? Would adding more memory help?

DISCUSSION -----

Only the last 10 unread pages are shown in the In Box to conserve system memory for other tasks (such as handwriting recognition) and to reduce the memory overhead of maintaining the In Box.

Adding extra memory to the MessagePad will not help because the extra memory would be allocated to the user and not the Newton operating system.

To view the pages that are not shown in the In Box, open the Pager application in the Extras drawer.
