## Super ATM: Problems After Rebuilt Desktop (2/94)

Revised: 2/25/94 Security: Everyone Super ATM: Problems After Rebuilt Desktop (2/94) \_\_\_\_\_\_ Article Created: 23 February 1994 TOPIC -----After I rebuilt my desktop file, some files are displayed as generic icons. Also, some documents which previously opened, now won't open when I double click them. In the Get Info window, these icons are named "Document". What causes this? DISCUSSION -----This is caused by having Super Adobe Type Manager (ATM) loaded when you rebuilt your desktop. Adobe is aware of the problem and recommends the

following workaround:

- 1) Turn off Super ATM and restart your system. You can do this by:
  - Turning off Super ATM from the Control Panel

OR

- · Rebooting your Macintosh with the Shift key held down to turn Extensions
- 2) Rebuild your Desktop file by restarting your Macintosh and holding the Option and Command keys down during the startup process.
- 3) Turn on Super ATM and restart your Macintosh.

According to Adobe, this problem fixed in version 3.6 of Super ATM.
