DISCUSSION -----

There is nothing tricky about installing PowerTalk Direct Dialup on a Power Macintosh.

1. Yes, Direct Dialup is compatible with the Power Macintosh.
2. Direct Dialup installs normally over a correctly installed PowerTalk for Power Macintosh.
3. No. No other disks are needed.
4. I presume you mean is the GeoPort for Power Macintosh compatible with Direct Dialup. Yes, it is.
