How can I move my PowerShare Catalog and Mail Servers from the current PowerShare hard drive to one of my other hard drives? DISCUSSION ------The steps for doing this are as follows: 1) Move the PowerShare Catalog Data and the PowerShare Mail Data folders to the new hard drive. 2) Delete PowerShare Catalog Prefs and PowerShare Mail Prefs from the Preferences located in the System Folder of the Startup Disk. 3) Launch the PowerShare Catalog Server. 4) When you launch PowerShare Catalog Server you will get a dialog box that says, "PowerShare cannot locate some of its configuration files." Click the "Restart" button in this dialog box. 5) Next you will get a dialog box that says, "The PowerShare Catalog Server cannot find its data folder." Select the desired hard drive from the pop-up menu in the dialog box. 6) Repeat steps 3-5 for the PowerShare Mail Server.
