PowerTalk and Windows NTAS Server (10/94)

TOPIC -----

Windows NTAS server does not show up, nor can be added, to a PowerTalk catalog.

DISCUSSION -----

Microsoft NTAS version 3.1 sends an NBP Lookup reply that contains a an invalid number in the "enumerator" field (254 in our case), apparently the PowerTalk catalog manager is dropping this reply packet. However, the NTAS server will show up in the Chooser which seems to knows it's an invalid number, and sets it to 1.

The fix is to install the "Microsoft Windows NT 3.1 US Service Pack 2", available from the Microsoft Download Service (MSD). You can also call Microsoft concerning this collection of patches.
