Does Open Transport send IPX packets when communicating through Internet connections such as an Internet Service Provider?

DISCUSSION -----

No. Open Transport uses TCP/IP for Internet communication and does not use the IPX protocol Internet connections, the IPX protocol is used with Novell Netware servers.
