TOPIC -----

How do I print a list of exported file systems?

DISCUSSION -----

By using the "-e" option with the /usr/etc/showmount command, you can quickly list the directories you have exported to other systems on the network.

Example output from the command line "showmount -e" executed the command line from the system "my_system_name":

```
export list for my_system_name:  
/users      machen redpony  
/           machen redpony
```

This example says that the directories "/" and "/users" are exported to the systems "machen" and "redpony" only.

In A/UX 3.0, /etc/exportfs can be used. With no options, all exported file systems are listed.
