TOPIC -----

I have A/UX 3.0 installed on a Quantum LP240S disk (Alliance Peripheral Systems). I need the correct information for this drive for the /etc/disktab file.

DISCUSSION -----

The Quantum LP240S drive is the same mechanism used for the Apple 230MB drive.

The following entries apply to both the Apple 230MB and the Apple 400MB drives:

```
# Quantum LP240S, Apple 230MB drive
#
LP240S|HD230SC:\
      :ty=winchester:ns=60:nt=4:nc=1930:
```

```
# Seagate ST1480, Apple 400MB drive
#
ST1480|HD400SC:\
      :ty=winchester:ns=54:nt=9:nc=1760:
```

The entries for the file /etc/disktab can be created from the drive specifications, and we don't have access to all the drives in the market.

You should be able to request the following information from the vendor to create entries:

Number of Heads = nt

Number of Sectors/Track = ns
Number of Cylinders/Disk = nc

To locate a vendor's address and phone numbers, use the vendor name as a search string.
