TOPIC -----

I have an Apple OneScanner, and want to connect it to my MS-DOS computer. The Windows Accessory kit is not available, so what type of SCSI card should I use? Also how do I obtain the Window drivers for this Scanner?

DISCUSSION -----

Any adaptec SCSI adapter (or compatible) will work - the Adaptec 1540 or 1542 SCSI controllers are good choices. The software that we ship with the OneScanner for Windows is called Ofoto and is available from Light Source. These would be the best choices, as they've been tested with the scanner.

To locate a vendor's address and phone numbers, use the vendor name as the search string.
